### PAUL'S SERMON 21st OCTOBER

**If Jesus is the answer, what is the question?** A couple of things to think about before then: We now know what the disciples didn't know then. The road that Jesus is walking is a road that leads to torture, to death on a cross. The "cup" that Jesus is to drink is the cup of his horrible death. The "baptism" that will drown him is the baptism of his death as he suffocates to death on a cross.

What is the core message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ?

Is this still relevant in today's world?

What is Jesus saying to you about your life today?

How do we share that understanding with those around us?

Is this all too hard?

This will also be the basis for Home Group who will meet after church, 21st October in the hall.
