Pastor's Ponderings

Normally at this time of year my pondering for December would focus on either Advent or the remembering of the birth of Jesus. But not this year. The third chapter of Ecclesiastes reminds us of an unchanging truth: "For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven." Tuesday the 11th August 2026 will be the 10th anniversary of my acceptance of the offer of placement as Minister of Dayboro Uniting Church. In the Uniting Church ten years is a kind of mandatory maximum stay in a church for minister in placement. Although under certain circumstances exceptions can be made to stay an extra year or two.

For all this time, I have felt called by God to serve as the minister in placement as your Pastor. Not only have I felt called by God to serve here at Dayboro Uniting, I have also greatly enjoyed the privilege of serving as pastor to this wonderful community of faith. But as the great American poet Bob Dylan once said "the times they are a-changin'". Life is never static. Change as "they" say is inevitable. As almost all of you should know by now after discussions with Carolyn, Rev. Nigel Rogers, and much prayer, I have decided not to seek an extension to my contract and call beyond the ten years. Carolyn and I wish to travel together while we still both can as we traverse our mid 60's.

Carolyn & I are both grateful to God, and our faith community here in Dayboro for the love and support we have received over all these years. One of the most important things in life is saying "good-bye" in healthy ways. After discussions with Rev. Nigel, at this time Carolyn and I are planning to remain part of our faith community here at Dayboro Uniting Church for as long as we call Dayboro home. So, this coming August will not so much be a good-bye as it will be a change of the roles we play in the congregation and community at large.

Once again, thank you for ten years of serving, laughing, crying, and doing ministry together. I look forward to your understanding, and continued support during this time of transition.
