# **Pastor's Ponderings**

#### **The Season of Pentecost**

Dayboro Day falls on Pentecost Sunday this year. So, we miss celebrating this unique holy day. And this next long season in the church liturgical calendar is called "Pentecost". Many churches mark Pentecost with a party, the "birthday of the church," celebrating with banners, red balloons, and maybe even a church birthday cake. We hear stories of rushing wind, tongues of fire, and cacophonous crowds. The church is born. Alleluia! The long-awaited day of the Lord is here!

But some would argue our world doesn't reflect that. War, famine, disasters, violence, youth crime, poverty... it is hard to pat ourselves on the back when it looks like "thy will be done" remains an unanswered prayer. I'm challenged to be involved not just as a passive pray-er, but someone who is actually involved in helping to bring about the Kingdom of God, and God's will being done on earth as it is in heaven. And not so much the greater world, but the world where I have a real chance to be involved and influence those around me.

As a congregation we have a pretty good handle on who we are. We are a people for whom God and all people are important. We are inclusive, welcoming, and accepting of everyone. 
Conversation Club:
