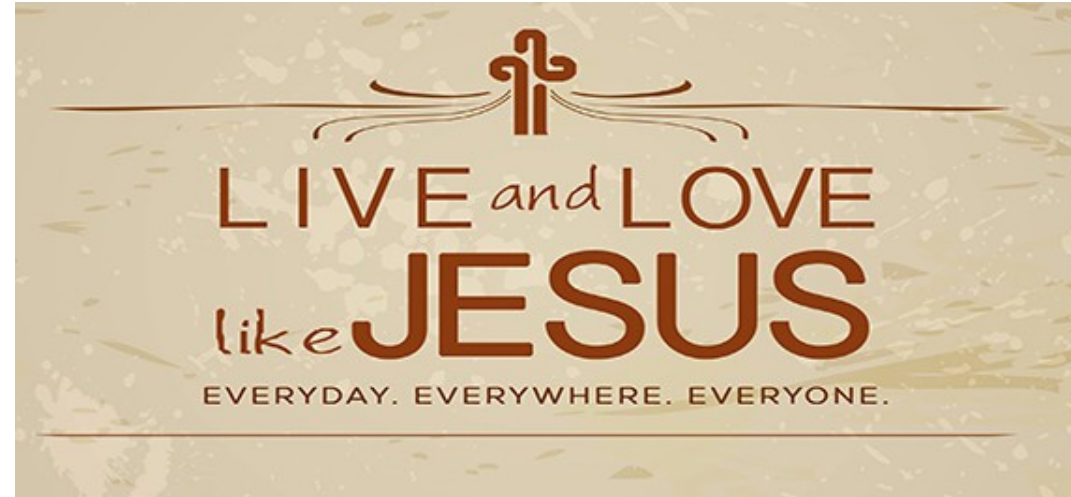
These dates are not set in stone and could be changed, however, we have to start somewhere.
