### **Reclaiming Jesus for Today's Community—Our Good Friday theme**

This is a strange community Jesus is forming—an extraordinary community. After a meal of lavish giving and sacrifice, Jesus bestows upon his disciples the power to leave behind their selfish preoccupations and to join the community of God's people who will carry God's mercy into the world. But the disciples haven't a clue how to be in community with each other. What should have been a warm, intimate gathering quickly deteriorates into an argument characterized by mutual suspicion and jockeying for power. For three years the disciples have watched and followed Jesus. For three years they have heard him tell about a topsy-turvy kingdom where the first shall be last and the last first; where the poor are royalty and those who are weak bring the greatest gifts; where children know more than adults about living in this kingdom; where you find your life by losing it in love and service. Three years, and still the disciples don't understand. They don't get it. They are worse than confused—they are clueless! Yet, their ignorance and blindness doesn't seem to disqualify them from being part of the community
