With Dan's approval, Paul has been invited to join the preaching team again and he and Robyn will take next Sunday's service (and more in future, hopefully). Paul brings a different perspective to the scriptures and theology which he has developed in recent years with the help of many friends in the progressive Christianity movement. Next Sunday he will present a message based on the Gospel of John and he calls it: *John's good news for the third millennium (that is for us as well as all others!)*

John had a lot to say to insiders'- those who were well versed in the religious practices of his day and who conformed to the rules. Paul will raise some 21st Century questions of John about 'outsiders' in a pluralistic world—our world of many cultures and mixed values. As John also lived amongst many cultures he should be something of an expert on living in our world.

However, John's advice to the powerless minority Christian group against a hostile majority (the Jews) that they were the 'true children of God' has been taken up by a later dominant power to us as a weapon for oppression and destruction of others who did not 'have the truth'. This oppression happened in Christian history with the colonization of indigenous people across the world and in the Jewish Holocaust to name just two events.

As twenty-first-century Christians, we must acknowledge this part of our history when statements such as these in John's Gospel have been used to justify such action. In the meantime, marginalized and oppressed communities can hear John's message as assurance, empowering them to move out again into the world to challenge all the powers that oppress and destroy. **This in the good news.**
