SUMMARY OF CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING 19/06/2014

1. The Council has determined that the recent donations to the church will be allocated to three areas: infrastructure (mainly kitchen renovations and building repairs), Welfare and Education.
2. The plan for the renovation of the church kitchen was presented and agreed upon. The work for this should begin in about 6 weeks. (Thanks Heather)
3. Rick Symons has been organised to fix the leaking roof over the deck.
4. Richard has had the rear of church speakers connected and is seeking information on new microphones, mixer and amplifier.
5. We have a new industrial vacuum cleaner (thanks Heather).
6. Leanne addressed the meeting on the needs of Sunday Space. These will be addressed in the next Council meeting.
7. Leanne has donated a new and comprehensive first aid kit to the church. (Thanks Leanne)
8. Approval has been given to Mainly Music for the hire of a jumping castle to celebrate the 5th birthday of this excellent group.
9. Clean-ups:
 - a working bee will be held shortly to clean out the shed
 - an assessment of the material that is on the walls in the hall will be made. Anything not needed or out of date will be removed. Please check to see if anything you have on these walls is needed.
10. Gracie addressed the meeting on the work she is doing with young people after school and on Fridays. Financial support will be coming from the Combined Churches committee. Gracie will keep in touch with the Council regarding further support that may be needed.
11. A four-step ladder will be purchased so that the new, top cupboards in the halls can be accessed more easily
12. Glyn is preparing a submission regarding the options involved in providing a disabled toilet for the hall.
13. Jenny reports the financial situation of the church is good.
14. All Church Councillors now have a particular area in which they will be the 'eyes and ears' of the Council. They will report on an as-needed basis to each meeting in the needs, issues etc of their particular area.
