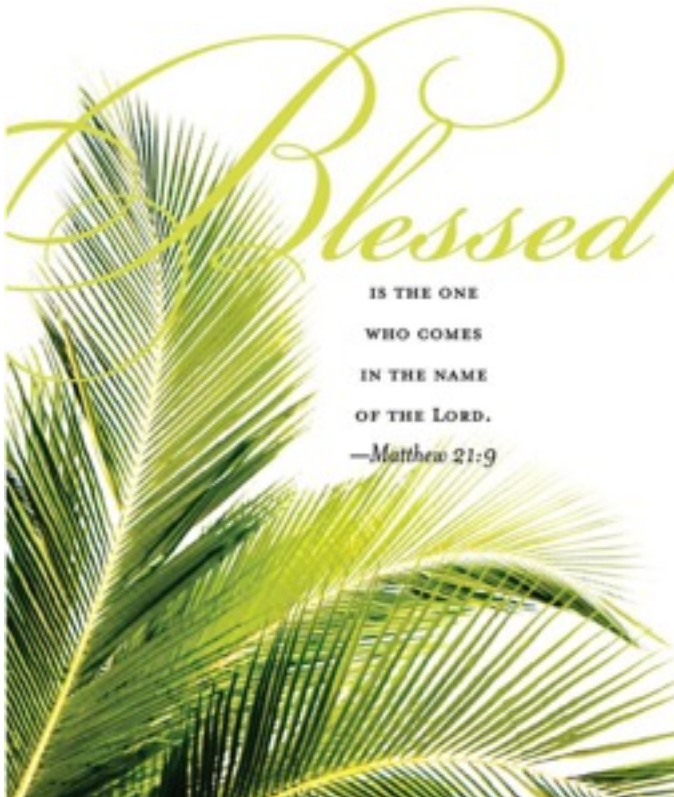

- Hand craft and books are welcome
- Soft toys in good condition are welcome
- Games, puzzles, toys, Lego, etc are fine.
- Or ask me if not sure.

If you donate to the stall, you need to be prepared for us to dump what is not purchased.

If everyone contributes a few things we will have a very respectable stall. I am also interested in borrowing folding bench tables and will pick up in my trailer.
