1. Kitchen refurbishment:

- final details have now been attended to

- the dishwasher is now functioning

- thanks to Heather for an epic job well done.

2. New Church Audio Visual System:

- to be installed for Christmas

3. Planning for Future Large Infrastructure Expenses:

- a sub-committee has completed this survey and a prioritised list has been created

- urgent jobs to be attended to are: the new AV system and new chairs for the hall.

- next in importance is the painting of the kitchen and hall and outside of the buildings.

- other items will be dealt with as funds become available.

4. Building Maintenance:

- Glyn (and Margaret) have attended to the following: mini ramps for all major doors, repairs to sensor light and switch in toilet, front lighting fixed, repairs to the back landing, repairs to the gate at the top of the ramp. The fly screen at the front of the church is to be in place in the coming week.

- Glyn has identified an ant problem in the kitchen. Could all members of the congregation who use the hall ensure that sugar etc is kept in ant proof containers e.g. a glass bottle. It appears that the ants are also into the urn by the gazillions. Please empty this out after it has been used.
