Pastor's Pondering

Growing up with a widowed mother who couldn't drive meant that I really felt that I was stuck in Dayboro. The closer I got to having a car & the licence to drive it the more I was determined to escape. I left here (for the second time) shortly after my 21st birthday. I mostly stayed away for the next 24 years, aside from the occasional visit to my mother.

God and circumstances flipped all of that on its head, bringing me back to my home community 19 years ago to pastor an Australian Christian Churches congregation. That didn't last more than a few years before I stepped down. I was back in the community I was born and raised in. Then some 9 years ago, after a lot of deconstruction and re-evaluating, I was honoured to be installed in placement as Pastor

of Uniting Church Dayboro. That experience has shaped what I believe about living in and loving our communities as Jesus would.

What I have learned over these 19 years, being back in Dayboro, and what I hope to hint at here is what I believe our ministry and mission are hinged on: falling in love with the place where God has put you. Because when you fall in love with the place, you inevitably fall in love with the people. You begin to see God in new ways, and then you see and recognize the people who are made in God's image all around you.

How do we learn to fall in love with our place, our community? MY experience in

pioneering a church in the Brisbane Valley at Lowood was reconfirmed here, I started to get more involved in the community, joining clubs, attending events that I once would have avoided as a matter of introverted principle. Doing so, I met my neighbours, I met new people. Sometimes it's easy for us as Christians (and particularly as ministers) to see ourselves as God's agent for blessing others. What I began to learn was these community members were God's aifts to me.

Our Church and dare I say it, our homes, ought not be fortresses to keep out the people we are called to love, and at the same time we keep them out, we lock ourselves in. We as members of this congregation need to connect with our community - on their terms, even in their places before we can expect them to sit in our pews on a Sunday. They may never sit in our pews, and that must be okay with us.

When you start loving people the way that Jesus would - unconditionally, not based on what they've done for you or what they might do for you, but just because they're created in the image of God — then maybe people might begin to ask you questions about why you love them even if they aren't responding the way you hoped. The bottom line is sometimes people aren't ready for a Saviour; sometimes they just need a neighbour, sometimes they just need a real friend, and if they can find that in us, maybe we can lead them towards the Saviour.


There will be handouts for children to do in church the Sundays that there is no Sunday Space.
